



What exactly is a DryStack Marina?

When most boaters think of a Marina, they think of docks and a bait shop. A DryStack marina adds a totally different view on boating. Rather than boats sitting in the water, unused for extended periods of time and exposed to the elements, boats are stored in a covered building on a boat rack.

They are moved to the water using a high capacity boat forklift on demand. This keeps the boats protected from the weather while at the same time allowing for a rapid launch and recovery.



What do I do with my trailer?

- If needed, for a modest fee we can store your trailer onsite.
- Alternatively, since it will not be needed to put your boat in the water, it can be stored at home in an out of the way location.
- You could even sell it! [We have some customers who don't even own a trailer.]

What about fuel and supplies for my boating adventure?

- We sell our mid-grade marine ethanol free fuel to our rental customers AT COST!
- Our Ship's store has Ice, Bait, snacks, marine supplies and even minor repair items at normal retail pricing.



What are the advantages of a DryStack?

The biggest advantage is that of time required for you as the boat owner to launch and recover your boat when using a trailer instead of a DryStack. Here is an example:

Let's go fishing!

Ok... here is how it works when you keep your boat at home.

- Hook up the trailer to the hitch, pack the boat.....15 minutes
- Travel Time to the boat ramp.....30 minutes
- Stop for gas, bait and ice.....15 minutes
- Prep the boat for launching 5 minutes
- Wait for your turn to launch.....10 minutes
- Make three attempts to back trailer down ramp.....10 minutes
- Launch the boat [someone has to help!] 5 minutes
- Search for a parking space to park the trailer 5 minutes
- Walk to the boat dock and wait for boat 5 minutes
- **Go Fishing**..... 4 Hours
- Wait in line for an opportunity to dock..... 5 minutes
- Walk to car and get in line to retrieve boat.....10 minutes
- Make three attempts to back trailer down ramp.....10 minutes
- Trailer boat..... 5 minutes
- Unpack boat and strap down for travel10 minutes
- Travel Time to home.....30 minutes
- Wash down boat15 minutes
- Wait to dry before putting back in garage15 minutes
- Make three attempts to back trailer into garage.....10 minutes

Total Time spent fishing 4 Hours

Total Travel Time dealing with boat to and from..... 3 Hours

Total Time Invested 7 Hour

Result.... It takes nearly a full day to go fishing for 4 hours



How would this work if you kept your Boat at Rivers Edge Marina?

- Call Rivers Edge to arrange launch time 1 minute
- Travel Time to Rivers Edges [no trailer to haul]15 minutes
- Walk to the boat dock and get in boat 5 minutes
[Which has already has gas, bait and ice]
- **Go Fishing**..... 4 Hours
- Tie up to Rivers Edge dock..... 3 minutes
- Say Hello to our courteous dock hands..... 1 minute
- Unpack boat into our handy carts and walk to car..... 5 minutes

Total Travel time..... 45 Minutes

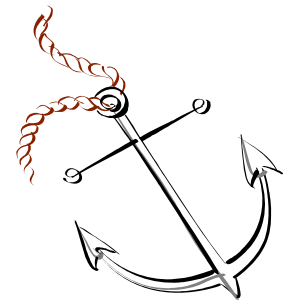
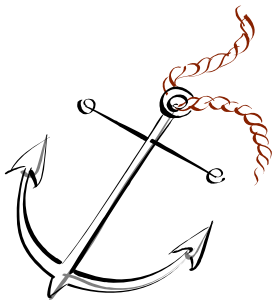
